Sharon Pratt Dixon actually launched her 1990 mayoral campaign with a lavish, well-attended party during the 1988 Democratic National Convention in Atlanta.

Hood & Associates, a boutique firm offering a range of personal, professional, and prophetic coaching since 1990, Hood Martin equips and empowers people for daily living.

The Reverend Dr. Barbara A. Reynolds, president of Reynolds News Service, is an award-winning journalist, author and college professor. She was a founding editor and columnist for USA Today and has recently published her third book: *No, I Won't Shut Up! 30 Years of Telling It Like It Is*. Dr. Reynolds hosts "Barbara's Beat," a Washington D.C. radio show and is a regular panelist on WHUT-TV's Evening Exchange program. She has appeared on Oprah, C-Span, and CNN. An ordained minister, in 1997 she launched Harriet's Children, a program for female substance abusers headquartered at Greater Mt. Calvary Church in Washington. Dr. Reynolds teaches at the Calvary Bible Institute and is working on her fourth book, the memoirs of Coretta Scott King.

Rocky Twyman is a community organizer, church choir director and public relations consultant from the D.C. suburbs who managed to draw some attention to himself for his profoundly moronic solution to surging gas prices in 2008: prayer. Lynne is the founder of "Lady of Divine Inspiration" and has reached out to countless victims. For the past nine years, Lynne has been employed with the Prince Georges County States Attorney's office Domestic Violence Division. She is a mother of three daughters and it is her strong conviction and passion to inspire and change lives from the inside out.

A seasoned radio talk show host with Radio One, owned by Cathy Hughes, Lyndia has her own show called "Think on These Things" - The Lyndia Grant Show. The show airs Fridays and is now syndicated on WYCB AM, Washington, DC at 6:00pm; and WWIN AM Baltimore, Maryland, Fridays at 5:30pm. Annually, to celebrate her radio show anniversary, Lyndia hosts a health fair. This year, it was held in Baltimore, Maryland, and three Baltimore City Councilmember's were in attendance, including the Council President.

Lyndia is a nationally, syndicated newspaper columnist. Her Religion Corner which has appeared in the Washington Informer for the past ten years was picked up by the National Newspapers Publishers Association (NNPA); and by Black Press USA. It has appeared in hundreds of black owned newspapers nationally.

Lyndia earned her BA Degree and MA Degree in the field of Communications from Trinity Washington University.

She has enjoyed speaking/training opportunities offered by federal agencies such as:

- U.S. Department of Commerce;
- Social Security Administration;
- U.S. Department of Labor; Office of the Lt. Governor,
- U.S. Virgin Islands, the Island of St. Croix,
- National Council of Negro Women, S.F. Calif.

Lyndia is a major special events coordinator, ranging from appointments from two U.S. Presidents to 3 DC Mayors; and several DC City Council Members. Served as lead event coordinator of the District of Columbia Committee's March on Washington, working with the city-wide chairman, Dr. Frank Smith. A national monument maker, Lyndia served as project director of the African American Civil War Memorial from the 1991 groundbreaking to the 1998 unveiling which was broadcast live on CNN, CSPAN and seen on 163 TV stations across the nation.

Though Lyndia is a Democrat, she was awarded a contract by the Inaugural Committee of President George Herbert Walker Bush, where she worked for the Republican Party; And for the Democrats, she worked as a staff member for President William Jefferson Clinton's Inaugural Committee.

She enjoys sharing with her radio listening audiences how her life changed forever, the day she read Napoleon Hill's book "Think and Grow Rich."

She is a domestic violence survivor; divorced after 17-years and has 3 adult children; and 3 grand children.

"Wherefore I was made a minister, according to the gift of grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of His power" (Ephesians 3:7).

Rev. Dr. Unnia L. Pettus has 23 years of public relations, marketing, creative writing, advertising, crisis communications, business management, coalition-building, public speaking, collegiate teaching, and research experience. In her career, she has served as a highly visible spokesperson in several roles, including her role as the Deputy Press Secretary then later promoted to be the Press Secretary to then D.C. Mayor Sharon Pratt Dixon, whose name later became Sharon Pratt-Kelly after getting married in the middle of her four year term. At the age of 23, Rev. Dr. Pettus was a history-maker as the youngest Cabinet member to serve in the Executive Office of the Mayor as a political appointee. News regarding her post resulted in a *Jet* magazine feature story.

Also, she was recognized as a "Top 30 under 30" in *D.C.'s Success Guide* magazine. Later in her career, she was hired to be the Strategic Communications Director for the 1.3 million-member Service Employees International Union (S.E.I.U.) of the AFL-CIO. She was also appointed to be the Washington, D.C. Metropolitan Area Press Secretary for the 2000 Democratic Presidential Campaign for Vice President Al Gore and Senator Joe Lieberman (D-CT.).

From August through November 2012, Rev. Dr. Pettus served as the African American Clergy Outreach Core Team Member for the Obama for America, D.C. Campaign. Immediately after the re-election, Rev. Dr. Pettus was appointed to work as a Faith Outreach Fellow for the 57th Presidential Inaugural Committee (P.I.C.). The food drive was recognized by the 57th Presidential Inaugural Committee, D.C. Director for The National Day of Service, Mr. Kouri C. Marshall, as a great success. In her role, Rev. Dr. Pettus held responsibility for recruiting pastors and clergy leaders to enlist their members to collect non-perishable food items, and to volunteer to sort and package the donated items at the event site for the National Day of Service. Hundreds answered the call to volunteer, and more than 4,500 cans, boxes, and other packages of food were collected and donated to local food banks, including Capital Area Food Bank and So Others Might Eat. In 2013 she was tapped to serve as the Director of Faith Outreach for the successful election of DC Councilmember Anita Bonds (D-DC) to the seat of DC by a margin of just 10 points.

From January 2010 to March 2015, Rev. Dr. Pettus, served as an ordained Associate Minister of Independent Church of God in Washington, D.C. under the esteemed leadership of Pastor Claritha A. Stewart. During her 5 year tenure, she served as Vice-Chair of the Women's Ministry, a co-instructor for the weekly Adult Sunday School class, and as a member of the Praise & Worship Ministry.

Pettus is the proprietor of Pettus & Associates, as a public relations and marketing consultant for clients with projects targeting specialty audiences, including the faith community. Currently, she serves as an Adjunct Professor teaching public relations in the School of Communications at Howard University. She also serves in full-time ministry through counseling and outreach to domestic violence victims and survivors through her ministry, Nobody But God Outreach Ministry.

A CEREMONIAL RESOLUTION
21-22
IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
March 3, 2015

To recognize and honor Mrs. Lillian Huff for her charitable and civic contributions to the District of Columbia.

WHEREAS, Lillian Huff is a Ward 5 resident, mother, civic leader, civil rights advocate, women's rights leader, Democratic activist, and graduate of West Virginia State University;

WHEREAS, Lillian Huff served as President of the Friends of Lamond-Riggs Neighborhood Library, as Vice-President of the D.C. Federation of the Friends of the Library, as President of the Lamond-Riggs Civic Association, and has remained a committed community and political leader in the Lamond-Riggs community and throughout the District;

WHEREAS, Lillian Huff chaired the first and only D.C. Statehood Constitutional Convention on January 30, 1981, the first formal step toward establishing the state of New Columbia;

WHEREAS, Lillian Huff was honored by Mayor Marion Barry for her contribution to self-determination because of her work with the Self-Determination for D.C. Coalition (1971 – 1985);

WHEREAS, Lillian Huff served on the Democratic National Committee ("DNC") as National Committeewoman for the District of Columbia;

WHEREAS, Lillian Huff was instrumental in the formation of the National Federation of Democratic Women ("NFDW"), was responsible for the motion that designated 3 seats on the DNC for the NFDW, played a pivotal leadership role in organizing a chapter in Washington, D.C., and became the charter President of the D.C. Federation of Democratic Women;

WHEREAS, Lillian Huff was an African American Female Delegate to the 1972 and 1980 Democratic National Conventions; and

WHEREAS, Lillian Huff continues to use her extensive knowledge of the Democratic Party, the DNC, the NFDW, the District of Columbia Democratic State Committee, and the political process to provide advice and counsel to political candidates and leaders from every quadrant of the District of Columbia.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that the Council of the District of Columbia recognizes Mrs. Lillian Huff and her contributions to the District as a community and political leader.

Sec. 2. This resolution may be cited as the "Lillian Huff Recognition Resolution of 2015".

Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon the first day of publication in the District of Columbia Register.
